## Kids Fitness & Wellness Corner



### Did you know:

**Children 4-6 years old should have each day:** ¼ cup of fruit cooked frozen or canned; ½ piece fresh fruit and 1/3 cup of 100% fruit juice

**Children 7-10 years old should have each day:** 1/3 cup fruit: cooked, frozen or canned; 1 piece fresh fruit and ½ cup of 100% juice

### A couple tips on how to get them to accomplish this goal...

1. Let them pick their own fruit; maybe red is their favorite color; raspberries, apples and red pears would suit their palate
2. Mix it up; canned fruit gets a bad rap but can be healthy if chosen selectively; fresh is great but keep the dried fruit to a minimum it is loaded with sugar as well as juice make sure you choose 100% juice
3. Slice their fruit: slicing fruit in smaller portions helps them to handle it better, and gives them more power over feeling like they have accomplished something. Do a little math game with them have them subtract each piece they eat from the whole sliced snack
4. Eat fruit with them, and keep trying! Sometimes you have to offer a fruit over 5 times to get kids to try it, like it and incorporate it as a favorite!
