Goals of Dual Language

The goal of a dual language program is for students to become bilingual, biliterate, high achieving, and globally competent.



Current Dual Language Programming

Schools with Dual Language Programming: Serving a Total of 1,269 Students

- *Brentwood (phasing out): 43 students*
- *Byrd: 145 students*
- *Clearmont (PDL): 180 students*
- *Frost: 137 students*
- *John Jay: 238 students*
- *Juliette Low: 148 students*
- *Rupley: 125 students*
- *Salt Creek: 253 students*



Successes

Recent Improvements:

- New high quality curricular resource
- Dual Language instructional coaches and continually increasing bilingual resource support



Challenges

- Singletons
 - DL = 14, Monolingual = 24
- Class sizes
 - Range 8-25
- Bilingual education compliance
 - Anticipate 40 DL classes out of compliance
- Physical space limitations
- Teacher assignment instability
- Students ability to access programming
 - Currently 28.2% of students do not attend their home school in order to access bilingual education services



Possible Options to Address Multilingual Learner Needs:

- Program Consolidation
 - Create Dual Language Academies
- Boundary Changes
 - Adjust individual school boundaries to balance student enrollment
- Building Construction
 - Create schools that can house multiple programs while eliminating singletons
