DATA HIGHLIGHTED & TARGETS



- Achievement: Student Grade Level Achievement data will compare as well or better than the i-Ready National averages in reading & math.
- Growth: Student Typical and Stretch Growth will meet or exceed the i-Ready designated targets in reading & math.
- Intervention: Students receiving interventions will gain a minimum 4 percentile points in reading & math.
- Sense of Belonging: Student survey results will fall at or above the national average.




















i-Ready Math Proficiency Results Fall 2021 - Spring 2024














Typical & Stretch Growth Results: Reading


















MathReadingBehavior






Average Percentile Gain










Panorama Sense of Belonging Survey Results Fall 2021 - Winter 2024

Reflections: Strengths & Positives

- Overall achievement results outperform IL and the Nation in Math and compare as well to the National results in Reading
- When compared to the Fall of 2021 results, the Reading KPI has increased by +4.9 percentage points while the Math KPI has increased +9.7 percentage points
 - Overall 71 of 84 (84.5%) Reading & Math KPIs increased this year
 - Overall Math KPI now @ 70% and Reading @ 68.7
- Multilingual student KPI growth exceeded non-multilingual in both Reading and Math (i.e. Closing the Achievement Gap) for the 3rd consecutive year.
- Students met Typical & Stretch Growth targets at or above the iReady defined expectations
- Significant reduction in the students falling in the 2 & 3 or More Grade Levels below from Fall to Spring in Reading (-12 percentage points) & Math (-16 percentage points)



Reflections: Opportunities for Growth


- Results continue to show achievement gaps, with some quite significant, across schools & demographic groups
- The overall district, all grade levels, and most demographics & schools results continue to fall below our 80% Tier 1 KPI target
- Meeting stretch growth rates for students below grade level fall below students at or above grade level



Reflections: Actions & Analysis

- Ongoing analysis of intervention program impact by individual program and student growth by District MTSS Team
- Completed an end of year benchmark data & implementation review with our iReady support & implementation team
- Using spring benchmark data for 2024.25 planning related to class placement, interventions, etc.
- Conducting additional analysis around grade levels that have had consistent limited or lower growth over the last few years
- Celebrating and recognizing the consistent and ongoing growth over the last three years and the efforts of students and staff to make this happen
