





Computer Adaptive Assessment Diagram A student's assessment score is not based on the number of items answered correctly. Each new question administered to a student is determined by the student's performance on their previous questions. The student receives a scaled score that is determined by taking into account the difficulty level of all these questions and their correct or incorrect responses to each.







Strategic Plan Goal 1 - Student Growth & Achievement KPI: 80% or more of students across all groups will be adequately supported by Tier 1 instruction, as evidenced by Tier Level Data.

Why - 80% of students supported by Tier 1 (i.e. students scoring <u>></u>25th percentile) can be viewed as the "Critical Mass" where the core curriculum & instructional strategies are effective in meeting grade level learning for most students.






